“STOP in the name of” ICE...

The Board has purchased and installed an “**ICE WARNING**” sign. It is behind the **stop** sign at the corner of Derby Lane and Hunters Glen. <Please see photo below.> We suggest ALL residents beyond this Derby-Hunters Glen intersection (including those on Thistledown, Saddlebred and ‘upper’ Hunters Glen) **STOP** to check-out the sign before proceeding down the hill when temperatures are near-freezing especially with precipitation. **PLEASE SHARE WITH ALL DRIVERS AT YOUR RESIDENCE!**
